

**Foreigners, Foreign Media Have No Right To Meddle In Malaysian Politics – NGO

KUALA LUMPUR, July 20 (Bernama) -- Foreign media or foreigners found spreading false information or conspiring to topple the government by creating unrest must be dealt with severely.

Pertubuhan Minda dan Sosial Prihatin president Ramesh Rao Krishnan said the foreign media and foreigners have no right to meddle with the administration of our country (Malaysia).

Ramesh said the people should not be fooled by unreliable information spread by these irresponsible people.

"We have been ruled by foreigners in the past. Do not let history repeat. We, the people of Malaysia must defend our sovereignty for political stability, unity and racial integration," he said when contacted by Bernama today when asked about his decision to lodge a police report against the founder of The Sarawak Report, Clare Rewcastle-Brown.

On July 15, he lodged a police report and also handed a video and an email to the police to back the allegation against Rewcastle after former Sarawak Tribune editor Lester Melanyi from Sarawak who confessed that he had fabricated information about 1Malaysia Development Berhad (1MDB) on the whistle blower site.

Following the report, Urban Wellbeing, Housing and Local Government Minister Datuk Abdul Rahman Dahlan who is also BN strategic communications director, accused whistleblower site Sarawak Report of fabricating its damaging reports about 1MDB and the prime minister's family.

"I lodged the police report to avoid 'aliens' from corrupting the minds of Malaysians and corrode their trust on the Prime Minister," he said.

Ramesh said he would also send a memorandum to the embassy of Switzerland soon, urging the country when the Bruno Manser Foundation that is based in the country, to stop its association and funding The Sarawak Report.

He said the portal was set up to report on environmental issues in the region and not meddle in the politics of Malaysia.
