

**PM Expresses Condolences To Zainol Mahmood's Family**

KUALA LUMPUR, July 23 (Bernama) -- Prime minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak expressed his condolences to the family of the former chairman of the board of Tabung Haji and Pos Malaysia Bhd, Tan Sri Zainol Mahmood Thursday.

Zainol, 78, died of a heart attack at the Prince Court Medical Centre (PCMC) here, at about 9.40 this morning.

Najib in his Twitter message said: "I am told that former chairman of TabungHaji & POS Msia, TS Zainol Mahmood, has passed away. May Allah bless his soul. Al-Fatihah."

His remains would be buried at the Jalan Ampang Muslim Cemetery at about 5pm today.

Zainol is survived by his wife, Puan Sri Rajmin Rashid, 73, and three children namely Zairila, 50, Rajman Zareqh, 43, and Irazeqh, 40, as well as eight grandchildren.

Zainol, who hailed from Kangar, Perlis, began his career in the civil service as Assistant District Officer in Kuala Lumpur in 1961 and had held several top posts in the federal and state government administrations, with the last being the Home Ministry Secretary-General, from May 1990 until his retirement in April 1992.

He was appointed as the Executive Chairman of Pos Malaysia Berhad from April 1992 to 2001, and as Tabung Haji Chairman from Aug 1, 2000 to Aug 7, 2005.
