

**Plane door washed up on Reunion island, says report**

Less than a week after a wing flap suspected to be from Malaysia Airlines flight MH370 was found on Reunion Island, Sky News today reported that a plane door has been found washed up on the island's shores.

The report said the plane door was found in a different location on the island.

The wing flap that was found earlier this week is now in France undergoing tests to determine if it is part of the MH370 aircraft.

Malaysian authorities are also in Paris awaiting results.

Aviation experts hope to verify the wing flap's serial number as well.

Many reports said the the wing flap most probably came from a Boeing 777, which is the aircraft model of the MH370.

Discovery of the debris may finally confirm the plane crashed into the sea after veering off course, helping to end 16 months of lingering uncertainty for relatives.

Investigators believe someone deliberately switched off MH370's transponder before diverting it thousands of miles off course. Most of the passengers were Chinese.

The debris will be analysed at a lab staffed by 600 experts that is operated by the French defence ministry near Toulouse.

An island local also found a luggage fragment, which will be sent to a police unit outside Paris that specialises in DNA tests.

In one of the most mysterious aviation incidents, the MH370 disappeared en route from Kuala Lumpur to Beijing in March 8, last year, together with 239 crew and passengers. – August 2, 2015.
