

**PAS to cut ties with PKR if it teams up with GHB, DAP, says Haron Din**

PAS is ready to cut its ties with PKR if the latter opts to form a new opposition coalition with DAP and PAS splinter movement Gerakan Harapan Baru (GHB), its spiritual leader Dr Haron Din reportedly said.

Mingguan Malaysia reported Haron as saying that PAS might have to take such a stand after PKR de facto leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim's recent statement that a new opposition coalition would be formed.

"With such a decision, the coalition is over and we have to go our separate ways," he said.

"If they want to form a new coalition, I wish them all the best."

He also said PAS would remain steadfast in championing Islam even if some of its prominent members were set to break away from the party.

This, he said, was because PAS had gone through similar situations with the forming of splinter parties, such as Berjasa and Hamim.

"Hopefully GHB does not remain as just a hope, time will tell. If time permits, we will see what happens," he said.

Anwar said on Wednesday that GHB would be part of the new coalition once it sets up a political party, which it was currently trying to do.

DAP parliamentary leader Lim Kit Siang previously said PAS would not be part of the coalition as it was the cause of Pakatan Rakyat's demise.

Pakatan was declared over last month after PAS's fractious muktamar during which it passed a resolution to sever ties with DAP.

The party's rigorous pursuit of the implementation of hudud law in Kelantan was to blame for the breakdown in relationship with DAP in the past year. – July 26, 2015.
