

Bank Negara denies rumours of Zeti's heart attack

Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) today denied rumours in the social media that its governor, Tan Sri Zeti Akhtar Aziz, suffered a heart attack.

This comes after talks circulating in the social media and markets since yesterday that Zeti, who is part of the special task force probing allegations against 1Malaysia Development Berhad (1MDB), has resigned from her position due to health reasons.

Reuters reported today that BNM has denied the rumour.

"This is not true." the newswire quoted a central bank spokesman as saying.

The Star Online also contacted BNM and a spokesman denied that the governor had suffered a heart attack.

"She is fine and came to work as usual," the spokesman reportedly said.

Zeti, 67, is part of a high level task force investigating claims made by The Wall Street Journal that some RM2.6 billion was channelled into prime minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak's accounts.

Two days ago, Tan Sri Abdul Gani Patail, who was part of this task force, was removed as Attorney-General and replaced with Tan Sri Mohamed Apandi Ali. – July 30, 2015.
