

Perkasa urges Putrajaya for Bumiputera economic master policy

Pertubuhan Pribumi Perkasa Malaysia (Perkasa) today has urged the government to create a master policy to manage existing Bumiputera economic development policies.

Its president, Datuk Ibrahim Ali, said even though the country has development plans every five years, there was no master policy that could be used as reference on managing Bumiputera economic development policies or programmes.

"Countries like Singapore and Switzerland have master policies to manage different types of policies so that they are isolated and managed individually."

He said many policies would change over time and due to to this, a lot of confusion has risen and widened the economic gap between races, the rich the poor and urban and rural areas.

Ibrahim said the proposal was submitted to Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Abdul Wahid Omar in a two-hour meeting on the 11th Malaysia Plan. – Bernama, July 30, 2015.
