

**MACC: Investigation On RM2.6 Billion In Prime Minister's Account Still On

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 23 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) is still investigating SRC International Sdn Bhd and RM2.6 billion funds deposited in the Prime Minister's bank account.

MACC also refuted the statements by several quarters that MACC Chief Commissioner Tan Sri Abu Kassim Mohamed or MACC had issued statements that both the investigations had been closed.

"In this regard, MACC stresses that the investigation on the case of SRC International Sdn Bhd and the RM2.6 billion are still going on," MACC said in a statement here, Sunday.

SRC International Sdn Bhd was a subsidiary of 1Malaysia Development Bhd (1MDB) before it was taken over by the Finance Ministry in 2012.

MACC said it hoped that no other quarters would be issuing statements which could confuse the people and build a negative perception of MACC.

MACC, in the statement, also reiterated its statement, prior to this, that the RM2.6 billion fund was a donation from a donor in the Middle East and not funds from 1MDB.
