

**Probe Starts Wednesday On Whether Flaperon Came From Mh370: Liow

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 3 (Bernama) -- The process of verifying whether an aircraft flaperon recovered on Reunion Island in the Indian Ocean is from the Malaysia Airlines missing flight MH370 will begin in Toulouse, France, on Wednesday, Transport Minister Datuk Seri Liow Tiong Lai said today.

He said the verification process would be undertaken by experts from Malaysia, China, the United States and France as well as the Boeing company.

"We will make an announcement once the verification process has been completed," he told reporters after opening Sekolah Rendah Jenis Kebangsaan (C) Bukit Serdang here.

Liow advised all quarters to refrain from making any kind of speculation on the recovered debris washed ashore on Reunion Island, saying it would put pressure on the next-of-kin of the passengers and crew and the public who wanted to know more about the find.

"As far as we know, the flaperon found last Wednesday is confirmed to be from a Boeing 777, but it is still too early to conclude that it came from Flight MH370. The same goes for the other objects recovered subsequently," he said.
