

**MACC Denies Senior Officers Involved In Conspiracy To Topple Government**

PUTRAJAYA, July 30 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) has denied that its senior officers are involved in a conspiracy to topple the government.

Articles in blogs claiming that MACC senior officers were involved in a conspiracy to topple the government were untrue and unfounded, the MACC said in a statement Thursday.

MACC said the senior officers were only performing their duties as directed by MACC Chief Commissioner Tan Sri Abu Kassim Mohamed.

"The responsibility of the MACC is to investigate corruption cases and not to topple the government," said the statement.

"MACC is responsible for conducting independent, transparent and professional investigation without fear or favour and regardless of who is involved.

"MACC will not allow any party to influence or interfere in an investigation," said the statement.

MACC said it was not involved in investigating 1Malaysia Development Berhad (1MDB) and was only investigating SRC International.

This was decided by the Special Task Force (Bank Negara, Police and MACC) who received advice from former Attorney-General Tan Sri Abdul Gani Patail.

MACC said the SRC International investigation will proceed with or without the Special Task Force until fully completed for submission to the public prosecutor for a decision.

MACC is tracing several important witnesses to wrap up the SRC International investigation.

"MACC pleads with the public to give its the space to complete the investigation," said the statement.

Abdul Gani's service as the AG was terminated on Tuesday as he is suffering from poor health.
