

French complete inspection work on MH370 wing part

The French-led investigation team examining the wing part or flaperon of the vanished Malaysia Airlines (MAS) flight MH370 aircraft has concluded the first phase of inspection work.

Australian Joint Agency Coordination Centre (JACC) said the French authorities would in consultation with Malaysia report on the progress in due course.

"The French investigation team is working as quickly as possible to provide complete and reliable information," the agency said in a statement today.

On August 6, international experts confirmed that the flaperon found on French territory, Reunion Island, last month was from flight MH370 – supporting an earlier conclusion that the MAS jet crashed in the southern Indian Ocean, about 17 months ago.

Flight MH370 went missing while en route to Beijing from Kuala Lumpur on March 8, last year. There were 239 passengers and crew member on board. – Bernama, August 19, 2015.
