

Why only Anifah denied receiving funds from Najib, asks Kit Siang

DAP parliamentary adviser Lim Kit Siang today questioned why only Foreign Affairs Minister Datuk Seri Anifah Aman publicly denied receiving any of the RM2.6 billion donated to the prime minister.

He said Malaysians were shocked that no other minister or deputy minister had responded to his challenge to the Cabinet that they each declare whether they received a portion of the funds for their 13th general election campaign.

"I commend Anifah for declaring publicly that he did not receive any funding from Datuk Seri Najib Razak's RM2.6 billion personal accounts in AmBank in 2013 for the 13th general election," said Lim in a statement.

"Malaysians are intrigued why Anifah is the only one who dared declare that he had not received any funding from Najib's RM2.6 billion personal accounts for his general election campaign."

Citing Najib's promise to allocate more funds for Barisan Nasional members of parliament (MP) next year, Lim added that Putrajaya's ability to distinguish right and wrong had worsened over the years.

Lim, who is also Gelang Patah MP, said it was apparent that Najib wanted to buy support and loyalty from Barisan MPs amid a possible vote of no confidence in Parliament.

Yesterday, Anifah responded to Lim's statement on Tuesday questioning whether he received money from the prime minister's personal accounts.

Anifah denied having any connection with the funds, and warned Lim not to insinuate that he had done anything wrong without evidence. – August 20, 2015.
