

**KL City Hall Allows Wednesday's Rally Only At Padang Merbok**

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 14 (Bernama) -- Kuala Lumpur City Hall has given permission for the organiser of the 'Himpunan Rakyat Bersatu' on Wednesday to hold the rally only at Padang Merbok.

"I have only allowed the use of Padang Merbok for the rally, that's all, and please gather peacefully," said mayor Datuk Mhd Amin Nordin Abdul Aziz when contacted by Bernama.

The letter of approval was issued today, he said, adding that he hoped that the gathering would be peaceful and the participants would not resort to doing anything unlawful.

Meanwhile, Federal Territories Minister Datuk Seri Tengku Adnan Tengku Mansor advised participants of the rally to adhere to all regulations.

Tengku Adnan, who is also UMNO secretary-general, said he hoped that the roads in the city would be left free by the participants.

Tengku Adnan said that if there was any violation of the conditions and regulations, the rally would become illegal and the approval would be withdrawn immediately.

"If UMNO members want to join the rally, they can do so. However, they must abide by the rules. They can be UMNO members, but they must obey the law," he told a news conference after the launch of and balloting for Residensi RazakMAS, a federal territory affordable housing project, here.

The rally is led by Pesaka, the national silat federation, with the participation of 250 other NGOs in opposition to the Bersih 4 rally held last month.
