

Malaysia Condemns Attacks On Al Aqsa Mosque

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 21 (Bernama) -- Malaysia has condemned the Israeli attacks on the Al-Aqsa Mosque and attempts to impose temporal and spatial dividing.

Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak voiced the condemnation to head of the Political Bureau of Hamas Khaled Meshaal in a telephone conversation today.
