

Mapim Calls On OIC, UNSC To Take Action Against Israel

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 22 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Consultative Council of Islamic Organisation (Mapim) today called on the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) and the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) to take action against Israel for its recent attacks on the Al-Aqsa Mosque.

Mapim president Mohd Azmi Abdul Hamid said Israeli attacks and attempts to have separate sections for Muslims and Jewish in the mosque had clearly violated the exclusive right of Muslims on the Al-Aqsa Mosque.

"As such, Mapim is planning to meet with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak soon to convey protest against the rude action of the Zionist regime.

"We also want Malaysia, as a non-permanent member of the UNSC, to make a stand on this matter. Besides the UN, the OIC should also be more firm in fighting for Muslim in Palestine," he told reporters after holding a meeting with representatives of 30 non-governmental organisations here today.

Also present was Malaysian Al-Quds Foundation chief executive officer Sharif Amin.

Mohd Azmi said the meeting had discussed, among others, the rights of Muslims on the Al-Aqsa Mosque and the Israeli attacks on the mosque.

He said Mapim would hold a peaceful assembly in front of the United States Embassy here after the Friday prayer on Oct 2 to protest against the recent action of the Zionist regime.

At the same time, he said Mapim also lauded the setting up of the Baitul Maqdis Fund and encouraged the public to channel their donation to CIMB Bank account number 8600499329 on the name of Al-Quds Foundation Malaysia.
