IPOH, Sept 3 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi said efforts by the Association of Wives of Ministers and Deputy Minister (BAKTI) in enhancing unity among its members should be emulated by all quarters, especially the young generation.

He was referring to the annual programme of Wives of Barisan Nasional Elected representatives or PTIWRBNM 2015 organised by BAKTI, which is headed by the Prime Minister's wife Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor.
