

MACC Hope Kevin Morais Will Be Found Soon

PUTRAJAYA, Sept 6 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) hopes Kevin Morais of the Attorney-General's Chambers (AG), formerly seconded to the MACC as deputy director of prosecution, would be found quickly and safe.

MACC's Investigation director Datuk Azam Baki said the MACC was shocked to learn of Kevin Morais' disappearance but hoped his family members would remain calm while the police carried out investigations.

Azam described the missing Kevin as a close friend when the latter was seconded to the MACC for 10 years before returning to the AG's chambers on July 1, 2014.

Kevin Morais was reported missing on Friday after he left his Menara Duta residence for work.

"I knew him well and we were close friends during his tenure with the MACC. I hope everyone will pray for his safety," said Azam.
