

**Singapore Air Quality Unhealthy Due To Haze From Indonesia**

SINGAPORE, Sept 24 (Bernama) -- Air quality in Singapore today was at an unhealthy level due to the haze brought in from Sumatera, Indonesia, by winds from the south and southwest.

As at 8am, the 24-hour pollutant standard index (PSI) ranged from 152 to 186, according to the National Environment Agency.

A 24-hour PSI reading of above 100 indicates that the air quality is unhealthy and between 201 and 300, very unhealthy.
