

**Integrity Pledge Must Be Followed By Plan Of Action – MACC

MELAKA, Sept 26 (Bernama) - The Integrity Pledge (IP) undertaken by government agencies and the private sector must be accompanied by a plan of action to combat corruption.

Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) Deputy Chief Commissioner (Prevention) Datuk Mustafar Ali said implementation of the plan of action was to ensure that corruption could be fully curbed.

"Our challenge now is corruption which can be curbed via IP. The plan of action is badly needed to give exposure so that it can be implemented in a practical manner.

"We must educate individuals, families and the society on the harmful effects of corruption and the importance of a community which has integrity," he told reporters after attending the 'Korban' programme and Forum Perdana titled 'Merakyatkan SPRM' in Alai here Saturday.

Mustafar said the MACC also organised several integrity programmes for the realisation of IP.

"Several states and agencies have already organised integrity programmes to combat corruption by spreading the message directly to civil servants and the public.

"The programme needs close cooperation of the people to enhance anti-corruption efforts," he added.
