

Now, sacked Anina sues Umno's Tengku Adnan

Former Langkawi Umno Wanita leader Anina Saaduddin is taking party secretary-general Datuk Seri Tengku Adnan Tengku Mansor to court for sacking her over the suit against Datuk Seri Najib Razak.

In her writ filed in the Kuala Lumpur High Court today, Anina is seeking an order that two termination letters issued by Adnan were invalid and had no effect on her membership.

She said she was taking legal action against Adnan because she was a Malay who loved her race.

"I am not a termite out to destroy the party. I only want to defend Umno from being destroyed by 'KuMan Lapuk' like Ku Nan who is in cahoots with Najib in his wrongdoing," she said in a brief statement.

Anina said she hoped her action today would pave the way for changes that Umno must be administered for the Malays and not for certain individuals,

She said Umno members must be respected because they were the backbone of the party.

The suit was filed through the legal firm Messrs Haniff Khatri.

Also named in the suit is Umno executive secretary, Datuk Abdul Rauf Yusoh.

Lawyer Mohammed Haniff Khatri Abdullah said the court papers would be served on the defendants once the sealed copies were obtained.

Tengku Adnan (pic, left), better known as Ku Nan, served two letters dated September 1 and 2 to Anina.

Anina, who caused a stir last month when she said Najib "urinated" on three million Umno members over the RM2.6 billion found in his personal bank accounts, had given Ku Nan three days to retract the removal of her membership.

Ku Nan did not respond before the deadline lapsed.

Anina was sacked from Umno after filing a suit two weeks ago against Najib, to make him account for the RM2.6 billion.

The money was said to be a donation from a Middle Eastern country, which Najib and his supporters in Umno claimed was held in trust by the president on behalf of the party.

Anina was accused of breaching Article 20.7 of the Umno constitution for bringing the party to court.

She had also lodged a complaint with the Umno disciplinary board to summon Najib to explain the controversy over the RM2.6 billion. – September 11, 2015.
