

DNA test to be conducted on Morais's remains

A DNA test will be conducted at the Kuala Lumpur Hospital tomorrow morning on the body found in a concrete-filled drum, said Datuk Richard Morais.

Richard, the younger brother of Attorney General's Chambers Appellate and Trial Division deputy head Kevin Morais, said the test would be carried out to help identify the remains.

"Although police have confirmed the body as my brother's, the process of verification will still be conducted by taking a DNA sample from a family member," said Richard, a businessman.

Morais's body was found in the concrete-filled drum in Subang Jaya yesterday after one of the seven suspects brought police to the location in a housing area in USJ 1 at Persiaran Subang Mewah.

The 55-year-old was reported missing on September 4 after last seen leaving his apartment at Menara Duta, Kuala Lumpur for his office in Putrajaya in a Proton Perdana with registration number WA 6264 Q. – Bernama, September 17, 2015.
