

Malays will not remain quiet when dignity challenged, says Zahid

Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Ahmad Zahid Hamidi said the Malays will not remain quiet and will rise to defend the dignity of the race when challenged.

"I don't want to use this occasion to recognise them (Himpunan Rakyat Bersatu).

"Do we keep quiet when our dignity is challenged and when we are pushed against the wall?

"Don't expect this to happen, we will rise to defend our dignity," he said.

Zahid, who is also home minister, said although the police estimated only 35,000 people attended the rally yesterday, those present put the figure at some 150,000. – Bernama, September 17, 2015.
