

**Minister compares UK's drone attack on Isis with Najib's need for secrecy**

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak can take advice from the attorney-general without having to divulge it, says Communications and Multimedia Minister Datuk Seri Dr Salleh Said Keruak.

"The PM can take advice from the AG and act on this advice, and keep this advice confidential," he said on his blog [sskeruak.blogspot.my](http://sskeruak.blogspot.my).

The minister drew attention to the debate in the United Kingdom focusing on the legality of Britain's drone attack on militant group Isis in Syria plotting an attack on Britain.

"The issue is whether Britain's action is legal and the (country's) AG said it was, and that whether the PM needs to reveal this advice, and parliament was told that the advice is confidential.

"Those raising all sorts of issues against the PM should best take note of this," he added.

Salleh further said that as to what acts could be considered detrimental to the country's security was entirely based on the advice of the intelligence community.

And these, he said, included economic sabotage. – Bernama, September 9, 2015.
