

KWAP has no investment in Mongolia, says PM

KUALA LUMPUR, There are no investments made by Retirement Fund Incorporated, or Kumpulan Wang Amanah Pencen (KWAP), in Mongolia, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak.

“As of Sept 30, 2015, KWAP does not have any investment in Mongolia,” he said in a written reply in Dewan Rakyat here.

He was answering to a question by PKR-Sungai Petani MP Datuk Johari Abdul, who requested the government to state whether KWAP had invested in Mongolia and the latest status of the investment.

In addition, Johari also asked the government to list down all domestic and foreign investments by KWAP and the value of each investment.

“The position of the domestic and international investment portfolio of KWAP from 2010 to Sept 30, 2015 amounted to RM39.05 billion, comprising equity, RM29.32 billion in lendings and private loan securities, RM29.10 billion in Malaysians government securities, RM6.16 billion in Money Market Deposits, RM1.09 billion in real estate properties, RM1.12 billion in private equity, RM5.18 billion in international equity, RM2.82 billion in international fixed income and RM3.91 billion in international real estate,” he said.
