

**Ahead of Umno assembly, Muhyiddin confirms addressing supporters tomorrow**

KUALA LUMPUR, Dec 6 — Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin confirmed today that he will be addressing his supporters tomorrow at the historic Kelab Sultan Sulaiman in the Malay heartland of Kampung Baru here.

The Umno deputy president's address tomorrow will be set just days before the Umno general assembly kicks off, where he has been barred from delivering any speeches.

"God-willing, tomorrow I will deliver a speech at the event with Umno deputy president, 8.00 pm at Kelab Sultan Sulaiman, Kuala Lumpur. You are all invited," Muhyiddin said on his official Facebook page tonight.

Umno secretary general Datuk Seri Tengku Adnan Mansor announced last week that Muhyiddin would not officiate the wings' assemblies, breaking for the first time a tradition that goes back 60 years.

However, Tengku Adnan denied that the party was trying to silence Muhyiddin.

Following that, Muhyiddin lamented that he will be treated like "a tree stump" during the Umno annual general assembly as he will not be given an opportunity to address party delegates.

Yesterday, Umno vice-president Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi said that the party's Supreme Council will meet this Wednesday to finally decide whether or not to allow party Muhyiddin and vice-president Datuk Seri Shafie Apdal to make their winding-up speech at the end of the party's general assembly next week.

News portal *Malaysiakini* reported today that Shafie would also be joining Muhyiddin in the appearance in Kampung Baru tomorrow, quoting his aide.
