

MCA Eyes Smart School Concept For SKJC

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 12 (Bernama) -- MCA plans to introduce the smart school concept at the national-type Chinese schools (SKJC) nationwide, starting with 20 schools this year.

MCA president Datuk Seri Liow Tiong Lai said the project dubbed "Smart School 2.0" was a continuity from the one initiated in 1998.

Under Smart School 2.0, the focus would be enhancing computer literacy among students, besides strengthening their proficiency in the English and Malay language, he told reporters after opening SJKC Wangsa Maju, here, today.

He said that students and teachers at the smart schools would design their own study modules by taking advantage of their own skills in handling ICT.

Liow, who is also Transport Minister, said there were currently 1,298 SJKC in the country.
