

Muhyiddin Attends 'Solat Hajat' Prayers For Flood Victims

KUANTAN, Dec 26 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin today attended 'solat hajat' prayers along with 1,000 worshippers at a mosque here to seek God's compassion to ease the severity of the floods ravaging the country.

The 'solat hajat' prayers, led by Imam Mohd Anuar Khazizi, were held after the Friday prayers at the Al Makmur Mosque, Batu 10 Camp, here.

Pahang Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Adnan Yaakob and Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Khalid Abu Bakar also attended the prayers.

Pahang Mufti Datuk Seri Dr Abdul Rahman Osman, in a statement to Bernama yesterday, advised all mosques in the state to hold the 'solat hajat' prayers after the Friday prayers today.

After attending the prayers, Muhyiddin went to Wisma Negeri for a briefing on the flood situation in Pahang. As at 3 pm, 35,736 people had been evacuated in the state due to the floods.

In SARAWAK, many mosques in the state held the 'solat hajat' prayers.

The Jamek Mosque in Petra Jaya held the prayers after the Friday prayers. It was led by the Grand Imam, Datuk Joji Suhaili.

In TERENGGANU, the 'solat hajat' prayers were held at the Abidin Mosque, also known as the White Mosque, and the Al-Muktafi Billah Shah Mosque, Ladang.

The prayers at the Abidin Mosque, attended by about 500 worshippers, were led by the Grand Imam of Terengganu, Aizi Saidi Abdul Aziz.

The prayers at the Al-Muktafi Billah Shah Mosque, attended by about 1,500 people, were led by Ustaz Mohd Bukhari Muhammad.

In NEGERI SEMBILAN, the Yang Dipertuan Besar of Negeri Sembilan, Tuanku Muhriz Ibni Almarhum Tuanku Munawir, attended the 'solat hajat' prayers with more than 1,000 of worshippers at the State Mosque in Seremban.

The 'solat hajat' prayers, led by Imam Zaherruddin Mokhtar, were held after the Friday prayers.

Tuanku Muhriz's sons, the Tunku Besar of Seri Menanti, Tunku Ali Redhauddin Tuanku Muhriz and Tunku Zain Al'Abidin Tuanku Muhriz, also attended the prayers.
