

**Almost 2,000 Flood Victims Happy With Najib's Visit**

KOTA BAHARU, Dec 27 (Bernama) -- Almost 2,000 flood victims seeking shelter at the Sekolah Mahad Muhammadi Lelaki evacuation centre, here were cheered by the visit made by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak at the centre.

The victims, who had been placed at the centre since Thursday, were pleasantly surprised as they had not expected the Prime Minister to drop by.

The victims were from several villages near the school such as Kampung Tanjung Chat, Kampung Telaga Nibung, Kampung Paya Bemban and Kampung Taman.

Their villages were under between one metre and three metres of water.

The Prime Minister, who was on a visit to observe the worst flood that hit Kelantan today, arrived at the school about 5pm and spent about an hour to observe the facilities at the centre.

Upon realising the presence of the Prime Minister, the flood victims who were mostly resting, rushed to welcome and shake hands with Najib who was escorted by International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed.
