

**Muhyiddin Scheduled To Observe Floods In Terengganu Tomorrow**

DUNGUN, Dec 28 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin is scheduled to visit Terengganu tomorrow morning to observe developments on the floods in the state.

According to a statement from the Deputy Prime Minister's Office, Muhyiddin would go to Dungun to attend a flood briefing and mingle with the flood victims at the Evacuation Centre at Sekolah Kebangsaan Durian Mentangau and the Kampung Nyior Flood Evacuation Centre, here.

Later, he was scheduled to make an observation on the flood affected areas in a rescue boat and would listen to the briefing on the latest developments on the floods in Terengganu from the National Security Council (MKN) Terengganu official.

Menteri Besar Datuk Ahmad Razif Abdul Rahman and several State Executive Councillors would also accompany Muhyiddin during the visit on the flood victims tomorrow.

The number of flood victims in Terengganu so far is reported at 35,857 from 8,802 families mostly in the districts of Kemaman and Dungun.
