KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 28 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak was granted an audience by Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice-President, Prime Minister of the United Arab Emirates (UAE) and Ruler of Dubai, in Dubai on Tuesday.
