

30 Anwar Supporters Recite Yasin In Front Of Palace Of Justice

PUTRAJAYA, Oct 30 (Bernama) -- In the past two days, supporters of Opposition leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim gathering in front of the Palace of Justice here were "pepped up" with talks by Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR), leaders.

But today it was a different scene with just about 30 supporters reciting the Yasin (36th chapter of the al-Quran).

They were seen reciting the Yasin besides the court building and also around it this morning.

Among them was National Laureate, Abdul Samad Muhammad Said better known as A Samad Said.

Petty traders were also seen carrying out their activities in the area despite a ban by Putrajaya Corporation.

Yesterday evening, a large tent, which was set up for the Putrajaya International Islamic Arts and Cultural Festival, commencing today, was used as a shelter from heavy rain by 400 supporters of Anwar.

Today is the third day of the final appeal proceedings of Anwar, 67, who is also PKR adviser, at the Federal Court against a five-year jail sentence for sodomising his former aide, Mohd Saiful Bukhari Azlan.
