

PM Thanks Those Who Help In Rescue, Rehabilitate Areas Affected By Floods

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 6 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak thanked all quarters who contributed in rescue efforts and in rehabilitating areas which were inundated by the floods.

Via his Facebook entry Tuesday, the Prime Minister said the deeds and sacrifices of numerous groups of Malaysians would not be forgotten.

"The flood water is receding but the rehabilitation and cleaning works are still needed and are being vigorously carried out. I want to thank all quarters who helped in rescue efforts and rehabilitating areas which were inundated by floods.

"The meaning of the saying, through thick and thin can be seen from the consensus and cooperation of numerous groups of Malaysians, from the national security forces, government bodies, non-government organisations and the public," he said.

The current flood situation in Malaysia, in general, is improving, with the number of victims moved to shelters dropping to about 30,000 people this evening compared to 200,000 people at the peak of the disaster.
