

**Stop pressuring Khalid to give up his seats, Faekah tells PKR

PKR leaders should stop pressuring Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim into giving up the Port Klang state seat and Bandar Tun Razak parliamentary seat as he still commands the support of voters in both areas, says his special officer.

Faekah Husin, in a statement today, said at the height of the Selangor menteri besar crisis, Khalid had been slapped with various allegations of abuse of power and corruption.

"Now that he is no longer the MB and has been succeeded by Mohamed Azmin Ali, the allegations have subsided," Faekah said.

She took umbrage that two months after his ouster, Khalid's detractors have yet to produce a single shred of evidence to back up their earlier claims and allegations. "Now that Khalid is no longer the administrator of Selangor, PKR is trying to pressure him into giving up his Port Klang state assembly position and the Bandar Tun Razak constituency."

"I urge these greedy and evil PKR leaders to stop their pressuring. Is ousting Khalid not enough? Must they continue to pressure him?"

Faekah said Khalid still commanded the support of voters both in Port Klang and Bandar Tun Razak as he was still capable of serving them.

"The rakyat voted for him in Port Klang and Bandar Tun Razak. They are the best judges of whether he should continue or not when the 14th general election is held."

She said it was bad enough that Khalid had been forced to step down as MB, now the state government had cut off his allocation for Port Klang.

"PKR appears to be too focused on ending Khalid's political career. Instead of focusing on administering Selangor well, they prefer to set their sights on Khalid."

She also took aim at Azmin, whom she claimed has been unashamedly announcing the water restructuring deal should be expedited and blamed Putrajaya for delaying the deal.

"Previously, Khalid was heavily criticised for the water restructuring deal and Kidex. Now the present Selangor state government wants to expedite both deals."

"Is the Kidex concession holder not an Umno lawyer? Has it changed in the past two months? Or has the Umno lawyer decided to support PKR?," Faekah said.

"How was it that all these allegations and claims could disappear in a second, once Khalid had been removed from the Selangor administration?" Faekah questioned.

Faekah stressed that whatever happened, come what may, Khalid would continue to serve the rakyat of Port Klang and Bandar Tun Razak. – November 2, 2014.
