

What happened to the reports on flooding at klia2, asks DAP lawmaker

As the video clip of the flooding at the RM4 billion six-month-old klia2 airport went viral, a DAP lawmaker wants to know what has happened to the reports on "flooding and ponding" which was promised by Malaysia Airport Holdings Bhd (MAHB).

Petaling Jaya Utara MP Tony Pua said that a YouTube video of airport workers scooping water in pails from the apron went viral overnight and had received over 16,000 views, revealing a serious crisis for the airport operator.

He said the Public Accounts Committee member was waiting for the report done by the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) and professional engineers Ikram on the construction issues at the airport as promised by the Malaysia Airport Holdings Bhd (MAHB).

"On PAC's request, MAHB agreed on September 30 to provide the reports by ICAO and Ikram, which are professional engineers appointed to look into the issues faced at the airport.

"This is because then acting transport minister, Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Hussein, had said three weeks after the opening of the airport that these two groups will be appointed to look at the ponding and flooding issues, which existed right from the very start," Pua said in the Parliament lobby today.

He added that to his knowledge, the reports were ready but MAHB had yet to hand it to PAC as agreed.

"Now, we would like to ask the Ministry of Transport if they have anything to hide with regard to the reports which they have not made known to the public.

"We call for these reports to be immediately submitted to PAC so that we can do a fair evaluation on whether these problems are really minor as they keep insisting or if they are structural problems that need massive repairs," Pua said. – October 30, 2014.
