

**Najib Conveys Condolences To Family Of Late Yuen

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 1 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak expressed his sympathy and condolence to the family of former Perak police chief Tan Sri Yuen Yuet Leng who died this morning.

He said Yuen's deeds and sacrifices would never be forgotten.

"Sad to receive news on the demise of national hero Tan Sri Yuen Yuet Leng. My condolence to his family. His deeds and sacrifices will not be forgotten," he said in his Facebook and Twitter tonight.

Yuen, who played an instrumental role in the historic 1989 Haadyai Peace Accord that witnessed the end of communist insurgency in Malaysia, died due to heart failure. He was 88 years old.

He left two daughters, Susan Yuen Sumin, 56, and Marina Chan Chean Gaik, 54, and two grandchildren, both in their 20s.

Yuen's remains had been sent to the Xiao En Centre at Cheras for the vigil service.
