PUTRAJAYA, Oct 15 (Bernama) -- Chilean President Michelle Bachelet has expressed satisfaction with the excellent state of bilateral relations with Malaysia.

In her remarks at the presentation of credentials of Malaysian Ambassador to Chile, Datuk Dr Mohamad Rameez Yahaya at La Moneda, Presidential Palace on Tuesday, she reiterated her government's commitment to further enhance cooperation with Malaysia.
