

**1MDB files report over leaked board meeting minutes**

1Malaysia Development Berhad (1MDB) filed a police report today over leaks of confidential company information, including minutes of one of its board meetings that was obtained by whistleblower website Sarawak Report.

In a statement tonight, the state investment firm said it lodged a police report because no action had been taken over Sarawak Report's admission of having obtained confidential documents from Bank Negara and from the Public Accounts Committee (PAC), as well as documents related to a government probe into the debt-ridden firm.

"Given this lack of action, 1MDB has today filed a police report on actions by one or more parties, who we suspect have leaked and/or sold confidential or proprietary information.

"It is our belief, that such actions were taken with one or more malicious intents and may have breached Malaysian laws, including but not limited to, the Penal Code, the Official Secrets Act 1972, the Houses of Parliament (Privileges and Powers) Act 1952 and the Standing Orders of the Dewan Rakyat of Malaysia," 1MDB said in a statement tonight.

The UK-based website has published numerous exposes on 1MDB and one of its recent reports was based on the minutes of a 1MDB board meeting on January 12 this year.

Based on the minutes, Sarawak Report accused 1MDB president and group executive director Arul Kanda Kandasamy of lying about repatriated investments from overseas. – October 12, 2015.
