

No confidence move against Najib will be tough, says Rafizi

Despite being one of the more vocal opposition leaders in pushing for a vote of no confidence against Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak, PKR secretary-general Rafizi Ramli today admitted that getting the motion through Parliament will be "difficult".

"We have to be realistic. It is not going to be easy," Rafizi told reporters at the PKR headquarters today.

Rafizi said that whether the motion of no confidence actually sees the light in Parliament is not within the opposition's control.

"We have to recalibrate the expectations. We don't want a situation where after Parliament, Najib is still in power, and people blame us," he said.

"We are not in control, Najib and the speaker is," he added.

Rafizi's comments comes days after BN's Gua Musang MP Tengku Razaleigh Hamzah also said that the no confidence motion will be difficult to push through.

Najib's fiercest critic, former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad, had also called for the motion to be voted on in Parliament.

However, Rafizi said that the opposition will still attempt to push it though.

"Yes it will be difficult, but we still have to try," he said.

Alternatively, he said, the MPs could attempt to vote out Najib's budget which will be tabled on October 23, automatically translating into a vote of no confidence. –
