

**PAS agrees to support no-confidence motion, says Azmin**

PAS has agreed to support a no confidence motion against Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak, PKR deputy president Mohamed Azmin Ali claimed today.

The party number two said that the decision was conveyed to PKR president Datuk Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail at a meeting this morning.

However, Azmin did not disclose the PAS representatives who met with Dr Wan Azizah, who is also the opposition leader.

"In the spirit of togetherness, we have agreed to table the motion but we will determine the time and process later," Azmin said.

PAS's participation in a no-confidence vote against Najib has so far been in doubt due to the non-committal statements of its leaders.

The Islamist party is not part of the new opposition pact Pakatan Harapan, and is on talking terms with PKR leaders only.

DAP secretary-general Lim Guan Eng had also accused PAS of being "ambivalent" and "ambiguous" about its support for the motion.

Azmin also said that he was "confident" that PAS would support the motion.

"We have had a series of meeting with them and the answers have been very forthcoming," he said.

PAS president Datuk Seri Abdul Hadi Awang previously refused to commit on whether PAS would support the motion.

PKR, DAP and the newly-formed Parti Amanah Negara, consisting of former PAS members, formed Pakatan Harapan recently as the new opposition coalition.

PAS has stayed out of the coalition, but PKR has stated that it is still trying to bring the Islamist party into the fold. – October 20, 2015
