

**Ringgit hits 5-week high, at RM4.16 against US dollar**

The ringgit jumped more than 5% to a five-week high today on stop-loss dollar selling and higher local stocks.

The ringgit, the worst performing Asian currency so far this year, surged as much as 5.2% to 4.1600 per dollar, its strongest since September 1.

Meanwhile, stocks in the FBM KLCI advanced 1.6%.

The ringgit and Malaysian stocks also found support from stronger-than-expected August exports and a rebound in global crude prices that eased concerns over the country's overseas earnings from oil and gas sales. – Reuters, October 7, 2015.
