

**Justo Lawyer Should Reveal Who Changed PetroSaudi Documents – PMSP

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 19 (Bernama) -- The Mind and Social Awareness Association (PMSP) has urged police to summon Xavier Andre Justo's lawyer, Worasit Piriyawiboon to Malaysia to cooperate in exposing the parties who altered the PetroSaudi documents.

Referring to media reports on Justo's application for appeal to reduce his prison sentence in Thailand recently, PMSP president Ramesh Rao said this was the best opportunity for police to call Worasit and prove that the documents which had been altered were purely defamation.

"I also feel that the media should publish the original documents as well as the ones which were altered to show what is the truth and what is not," he told reporters after lodging a police report at the Petaling Jaya District Police Station here today to request the police to investigate the statement made by Justo's lawyer.

Last Wednesday, Justo submitted an appeal against the three-year jail sentence imposed by the South Bangkok Criminal Court on Aug 17 for blackmailing his former employer, PetroSaudi International Ltd (PetroSaudi).

Worasit told Bernama last Wednesday that any damage to the image of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak was due to third parties who altered the documents which they obtained from Justo.

Among the justifications for the appeal to reduce the sentence was that Justo had not altered the documents he took from PetroSaudi and this was his first offence.

Justo, 49, was detained in his house on the island resort of Koh Samui in Southern Thailand on June 22 after PetroSaudi officials filed a complaint that he had tried to blackmail the company for 2.5 million Swiss francs (RM11 million) using documents he had stolen from the company.

Justo's case caught the attention of Malaysians because of previous links between PetroSaudi and 1MDB.
