KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 21 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi today received a courtesy call from Singapore Home Affairs Ministry Parliamentary Secretary, Amrin Amin at Perdana Suite, Putra World Trade Centre (PWTC) here.
