KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 28 (Bernama) -- Several Barisan Nasional (BN) members of parliament regarded PAS president Datuk Seri Abdul Hadi Awang's willingness to engage with the BN government for the sake of the people's interests as a proactive action that should be praised.
