

Bangladesh Describes Malaysia As Idol Of Developing Countries

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 29 (Bernama) -- Malaysia has always been an idol and 'benchmark' for developing countries, says Bangladesh Parliamentary Standing Committee on Ministry of Foreign Affairs chairman Dr Dipu Moni.

Dewan Rakyat Speaker Tan Sri Pandikar Amin Mulia said the matter was stated by Dr Dipu when she paid a courtesy call on him at his office in Parliament House here Thursday.
