

**Government Schools Now Subject To More Frequent Audit – Najib

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 29 (Bernama) -- The Education Ministry will carry out audit on all government schools, including the Tamil schools, on a more frequent basis to ensure safe and comfortable environment for the learning process, Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said.

The prime minister said the government viewed seriously the welfare of students, especially those in schools.

"These students are leaders of the future," Najib posted in his blog NajibRazak.com.

Earlier today, the prime minister made a surprise visit to Sekolah Jenis Kebangsaan Tamil (SJKT) Dengkil to inspect the condition of the school and the welfare of its pupils.

He also asked for several improvements to be made immediately on the school, especially to address the problems of open drain, wiring system, leaking roofs and broken fences, as well as to upgrade its science laboratory, canteen and library.

"I'm confident that with the move we are taking and the dedication of the teachers, the school's performance will improve, Insya-Allah," Najib said.

SJKT Dengkil has four blocks but only one is in good condition. It currently has 300 students, including 43 kindergarten pupils and 24 teachers.
