

Najib Wishes JDT Victory In AFC Cup Final Tomorrow

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 30 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak has wished the Johor Darul Takzim (JDT) football team a win in facing FC Istiklol of Tajikistan in the AFC Cup 2015 final tomorrow.

Najib, through his Twitter and Facebook postings, said he prayed for victory for JDT to create Malaysian history by bringing home the prestigious trophy for the first time.

"I pray for the Johor Southern Tigers' success in the AFC Cup final tomorrow.

"Hopefully, this prestigious trophy can be brought to Malaysia for the first time!" he said.

JDT created history by being the first Malaysian football team to go into the final of the AFC Cup following the cancellation of the semi-final second leg match between JDT and Al-Qadsia of Kuwait which was scheduled for Oct 20.

This came after Kuwait's suspension from all football activities by FIFA over the country's sports law interference.

The Asian Football Confederation (AFC) gave JDT victory, hence JDT will be going into the final against FC Istiklol at the Republican Stadium in Dashanbe, Tajikistan, tomorrow at 5pm (8pm Malaysian time).
