

**We'll interview Justo in Bangkok next week, says IGP

A team of police officers from Bukit Aman is to leave for Thailand next week to record a statement from Swiss national Xavier Andre Justo, who has been convicted of attempted extortion, over the probe into 1Malaysia Development Berhad (1MDB).

Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Khalid Abu Bakar said today the decision to send the team was made after Thai police gave the approval for Malaysian police to meet the former executive of PetroSaudi International Ltd.

"I anticipate that we will be able to meet him (Justo) next week for an interview and to secure relevant documents," he told reporters after attending the closing of a policing programme in Kuala Lumpur.

He said the Malaysian police had not been given a specific date yet on the meeting with Justo because the latter had to undergo case management. Khalid had personally tried to meet with Justo in July but was denied permission to do so by Thai police.

Khalid declined to elaborate on the team of officers to be sent to Thailand.

Justo, 49, is serving a three-year jail sentence after having been found guilty by a Thai court on August 17 of attempting to extort his employer, PetroSaudi.

His case drew interest in Malaysia due to the business dealing between PetroSaudi and 1MDB. – Bernama, October 23, 2015.
