

**DPM's Wife Offers Condolences to Federal Court Judge Over Son's Death**

PUTRAJAYA, Dec 10 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi's wife Datin Seri Hamidah Khamis arrived at the Putra Mosque in Putrajaya to pay her last respects for the death of Federal Court Judge Tan Sri Abdull Hamid Embong's son Darem Hakimi Abdull Hamid, 27.

Darem Hakimi died in an accident at Jalan Sultan Abdul Halim, at about 4.30am this morning.

Hamidah when met by reporters said she knew what it was like to lose a loved one and offered her condolences to the family of the late Darem Hakimi.

She said she too had faced unnerving moments when her son suffered severe injuries after being involved in a motorcycle accident two years ago.

"I had just spoken to Puan Sri Noor Kim Abdullah and told her to be patient and accept the fate of God. Allah loves her son more, and he awaits us in heaven," she said.

"On behalf of Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi, I would like to express our condolences to all the family members and hope they can cope with this sad tragedy," she said.

Darem Hakim's body arrived at the mosque at 12.30pm and was later buried at the Presint 20 Muslim cemetery after Zohor prayers.

Among those present were Minister in the Prime Minister's Department, Nancy Shukri, and Chief Justice Tun Arifin Zakaria.

In the 4.30am incident, the victim who died at the scene due to severe head injuries, was believed to have lost control of the car he was driving and crashed into a parked trailer before hitting the road divider.
