

Najib To Visit Turkey In Conjunction With G20 Summit

PUTRAJAYA, Nov 13 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak will be leading the Malaysian delegation to the Group of Twenty (G20) Summit in Antalya, Turkey on Nov 15-16.

Foreign Ministry statement today said that Malaysia had been invited to participate in the summit in its capacity as the chair of ASEAN.

The G20, a premier forum where governments and central bank governors from 20 major economies meet and discuss international economic and financial cooperation, is currently chaired by Turkey.

The foreign ministry statement said that Najib was expected to speak in sessions which will discuss issues that are relevant to ASEAN, such as the global economy, trade and terrorism, at the summit.

Themed 'Ensuring Inclusive and Robust Economic Growth Through Collective Action', the Turkish Presidency formulated the three 'I's concept of Inclusiveness, Implementation and Investment to promote growth.
