KUALA LUMPUR, Dec 4 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak has called on the people to cease all squabbles as well as stop spreading and believing in slander so as to ensure prosperity in the country.

"Let's not entertain matters which can divert our attention from the efforts to realise our vision (to achieve developed nation status)," he said in the latest post on his blog, www.najibrazak.com.
