

**Najib and I feel sorry for each other, report quotes Rosmah

Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor said she and her husband Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak both felt sorry for each other over the treatment they received on social media, Malaysiakini reported.

Rosmah reportedly recounted how her husband assured her that attacks against her on social media were actually aimed at ousting him.

"When I see (the slander) on social media, I ask (Najib), is this about me? Are they talking about me, this Rosmah?"

"He (Najib) will say, 'No. This is not about you. They want to topple me but they cannot, so they involve my wife. This is about me. They want to oust me through my wife'.

"He (Najib) feels sorry for me, and I too feel sorry for him. We feel sorry for each other," she was quoted as saying in a speech at the MIC headquarters in Kuala Lumpur today.

Rosmah also reportedly urged the audience not to believe the allegations about her on social media.

"I hope all of you do not believe any news on social media and spread it. We don't know its veracity. Otherwise you're no better (than those who made it viral).

"Don't believe anything on social media especially about me. Whatever you hear about me, check first," she was quoted as saying.

The prime minister's wife has often been the subject of ridicule on social media for her purportedly expensive handbags and hairstyle.

Critics have accused her of being out of touch with ordinary citizens struggling to make ends met. – November 24, 2015.
